SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 25-0085

On Jan. 7 at approximately 9:50 a.m., a police vehicle responding to a different crash was struck at Bromley Lane and S. 27th Ave. The police officers, who had their emergency lights and siren activated, slowed for the intersection. When they entered the intersection, they were struck by a driver who failed to yield to the emergency vehicle. Neither driver was injured, but the citizen driver was transported to the hospital as a precaution. The Colorado State Patrol handled the crash investigation.

Case Report 25-0098

On Jan. 8 at about 2:00 a.m., officers were patrolling around Hwy 85 and E. 136th when they came upon a truck stopped in the turn lane of the highway. Officers contacted the truck and its occupants and quickly learned the truck was stolen from Broomfield. The driver and occupant were arrested, and the officers seized 2.1 grams of suspected cocaine. A 31-year-old male was booked into the Adams County Jail on drug and motor vehicle theft charges.

Case Report 25-0140

On Jan. 10 at 11:30 p.m., officers were dispatched to a disturbance at Jordinelli's Bar, 25 N. Main St. Officers learned after a brief argument, a patron struck another patron, causing serious bodily injury. The suspect fled before the police arrived and remains at large.

Case Report 25-0184

On Jan. 12 at 7:20 p.m., officers were dispatched to El Palenque Bar, 400 N. Main St., on reports of an assault. A male was struck several times in the face by his significant other, who was armed with brass knuckles. The victim did sustain serious bodily injury, and the suspect is at large.

Case Report 25-0167

On Jan 12, in the early morning hours, officers took a report from a family who hadn't heard from their mother in several hours. Their mother suffers from extreme dementia, and the family was concerned about her whereabouts. As

the officers were investigating, a deputy in Laramie, Wyoming, contacted the missing person. The family was provided with the information and was able to reconnect with their mother.
