SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 25-0471

On Jan 28, at 2:00 a.m., police received a call for service on a suspicious vehicle near Farmlore Dr and Bloom St. Officers responded to investigate and found a male slumped over in the driver's seat. Officers saw a pistol magazine in the passenger's seat of the vehicle. The officers learned the male was a habitual traffic offender and had a previous felony conviction, prohibiting him from possessing a firearm. The male was arrested on the charges and booked into the Adams County Jail.

Case Report 25-0494

On Jan. 28, at 4:32 p.m., officers conducted a traffic stop near N. 11th Ave and E. 168th Ave. Officers learned the truck was a stolen truck out of Boulder County. The female driver had an active protection order protecting her from the male passenger in the truck. The female was arrested for being in possession of the stolen truck, while the male passenger was arrested for violating the protection order.

Case Report 25-0524

On Jan. 30, at 2:00 a.m., while on patrol, officers stopped a vehicle for a traffic violation. The officer learned that one of the occupants of the car had two felony warrants stemming from motor vehicle theft and theft charges. The individual was arrested and found to be in possession of 7.28 grams of methamphetamine. The individual was booked into Adams County Jail on the warrants and drug charges.

Case Report 25-540

On Jan 31, at 4:20 a.m., officers were dispatched to a structure fire in the 400 block of Rocha Way. Flames were seen coming from the side of the house. The fire caused significant damage. Victim Services and the Red Cross respond for the family that was displaced.

Case Report 25-0563

On Jan 31, at 6:17 p.m., officers were dispatched to Platte Valley Medical Center in reference to a patient who assaulted staff. A 33-year-old male, intentionally took out his IV and was throwing his blood in the face of the staff. He knew his blood was infected with Hepatitis C. Several nurses had blood on their body. He was later taken into custody for 2nd Degree Assault with intent to infect a first responder. He was booked into ACDF.

Case Report 25-0564

On Jan 31, at 6:04 p.m., officers were dispatched to Platte Valley Medical Center about a firefighter from Brighton Fire whom a patient had bitten. The firefighter was in his Fire uniform and helping transition the patient from one bed to another when he bit the firefighter's bicep. The male suspect was taken into custody and booked into ACDF on felony charges.
