SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 25-0622 : On Feb 3, at 3:40 p.m., Officers were on patrol in the Prairie Center when they noticed a vehicle with a fictitious plate. Officers contacted the female driver and found she had a warrant for her arrest. The female had 88 blue M30 pills suspected to be fentanyl and approximately .31 grams of suspected methamphetamine in her purse. She was arrested and booked into the Adams County Jail on drug charges and an arrest warrant.

Case Report 25-0636 : On Feb 4, at 9:30 a.m., Officers were conducting traffic enforcement near Bromley Lane and Prairie Center Parkway when they stopped a motorist for a traffic violation. The driver didn't have proof of insurance or a valid driver's license and was arrested. The driver was found to be in possession of financial devices that did not belong to him, over 1 gram of suspected methamphetamine, and several M30 pills suspected to be fentanyl. The driver was booked into Adams County Jail on the drug and several other charges.

Case Report 25-0648: On Feb. 4, at 4:30 p.m., Officers were dispatched to the parking lot of City Hall, 500 S. 4th Ave., on reports of a suspicious vehicle. When officers arrived, they found the suspicious vehicle running and noticed that two of the tires were shredded, missing most of the rubber. A 40-year-old woman was found passed out in the driver's seat of the vehicle. She was found to have active warrants for her arrest. She was also found to have over 18 grams of suspected Methamphetamine and .22 grams of suspected fentanyl. She was later booked into the Adams County Jail on charges of driving under the influence of drugs, possession of controlled substance, and the active arrest warrants.

Case Report 25-0655: On Feb 5, at 3:00 a.m., officers were dispatched to Smoker Friendly in the 1500 block of Bridge on reports of a burglary. Officers responded and found a Kia SUV had smashed into the front of the store. The Kia was left at the store and found to be a stolen vehicle. The suspects entered the store and stole merchandise. The owner estimated the thieves caused the store thousands of dollars in damage. This is an active investigation.

Case Report 25-0757: On Feb 10, at 1:10 p.m., Officers responded to a person with a gun at Taco Bell, 920 E. Bridge St. Officers made contact with the victim, who stated the suspect, a 23-year-old male, shoved him to the ground and reached for a gun that was tucked in his pants. This caused a panic inside Taco Bell, with several patrons and employees running out of the store or to the back kitchen. The suspect fled to his house in the area but was taken into custody by officers. A firearm matching the victim's description was located inside the home. The suspect was booked into the Adams County Jail on misdemeanor assault and unlawfully carrying a concealed firearm charges.
