### SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

**Case Report 25-0781:** On Feb 11, at 11:16 p.m., officers responded to a crash on I-76 near E-470. Upon arrival, they discovered the vehicle not at fault on the side of the roadway with extensive damage. The driver was trapped inside and required extrication. The individual sustained severe injuries. The crash was caused by a semi-truck traveling too fast for road conditions. The semi rear-ended the sedan, forcing it off the roadway, where it collided with a tree. The severity of the impact suggests the semi was traveling at a significantly higher speed than a sedan. Drugs and alcohol are not suspected to be contributors to this crash.

**Case Report 25-0815:** On Feb. 13, at 9:30 p.m., officers were dispatched to a residence on N. 5th Ave on reports of repeated 9-1-1 hang-up calls. Upon arrival, officers learned a female was attempting to call the police after a heated argument with the father of her children. The male broke the female's cell phone as she was trying to contact the police for help. The male was uncooperative with police and physically resisted arrest. The female did have an active protection order protecting her from the male. He was ultimately arrested on charges of domestic violence, criminal mischief, violation of a protection order, and obstruction charges.

**Case Report 25-0833:** On Feb. 14, at 4:50 p.m., officers were dispatched to the Super Target, 2171 Prairie Center Pkwy, on reports of a shoplifting. Loss Prevention Agents apprehended a 43-year-old woman for shoplifting \$389.00 worth of merchandise. The female was also found to have an active warrant for her arrest out of Douglas County. She was arrested on the warrant and booked into the Adams County Jail.

**Case Report 25-0865:** On Feb. 16, at 11:55 a.m., officers conducting traffic enforcement on Brighton Rd. at E. 144<sup>th</sup> Ave contacted a driver for swerving. The driver, a 54-year-old man, was found to be under the influence of drugs/alcohol. The driver also had an active warrant for his arrest and a revoked driver's license. The male was arrested and found to be in possession of over 2 grams of suspected methamphetamine. He was later booked into the Adams County Jail on the warrant and new charges.
