SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 25-0892: On Feb 18, at 9:00 a.m., officers were dispatched to reports of a male smoking narcotics in the parking lot of the Lowe's, 4980 E. Bromley Lane. The caller reported seeing a male using narcotics in a truck that was parked in the parking lot. Officers located the suspect's truck and found the driver, a 43-year-old male, sitting in the driver's seat with drug paraphernalia around him. The driver displayed symptoms of being under the influence of narcotics. He was arrested for suspicion of driving under the influence of drugs and an active arrest warrant out of Weld County. Officers found .98 grams of suspected methamphetamine and .89 grams of suspected fentanyl. The driver was later booked into the Adams County Jail.

Assist other agency-Adams County Sheriff's Office: On Feb. 20, Brighton Police assisted the Adams County Sheriff's Office Swat Team with the service of a search warrant at 20400 E 160th Ave. This location is in Adams County but is surrounded by the City of Brighton. The warrant service turned into a standoff shortly after the arrival of law enforcement. Negotiations were attempted but were unsuccessful. Around 11:30 a.m., ACSO Deputies attempted to make entry into the structure. During this attempt, the subject shot at the deputies, wounding three of them. Several deputies returned fire as they attempted to protect themselves and move out of the path of gunfire. The building the subject was in caught fire during the attempted entry.

The injured deputies received treatment for non-life-threatening injuries and a deceased female was later found inside the building that caught fire. The 17th Judicial District Critical Incident Response Team is investigating the officer-involved shooting. While this incident was not in the City of Brighton's jurisdiction, it significantly impacted the Bromley Park neighborhood and traffic on Bridge Street East of 50th Ave.

Case Report 25-094: On Feb. 20 at 3:53 p.m., officers were dispatched to a semi-tanker that rolled over on Interstate 76 near Eagle Boulevard. Officers found the driver to have injuries to his head, but he was walking around. The tanker was loaded with 7200 gallons of fuel. The tank was leaking, and Brighton Fire was able to contain the leak. Portions of I-76 were closed for over five hours as crews worked to recover the fuel, mitigate the fuel that leaked out of the tanker, and recover the vehicle. The Utilities team and Streets provided invaluable assistance to PD and Fire on this scene, with Utilities helping to mitigate the Haz-Mat leak and Streets shutting down the highway to ensure responders and crews could work on the road safely. The driver of the semi-tanker was cited for careless driving.

Case Report 25-0945: On Feb. 20, at 8:30 p.m., officers were dispatched to a disturbance at the 7-11, located at 1012 E. Bridge St. Dispatch received reports of a group of individuals causing a disturbance inside the store. When the officers arrived, they contacted a female in the area. She was found to have two active warrants for her arrest. The female was arrested and found to be in possession of methamphetamine.

Case Report 25-0974: On Feb. 22, at 2:57 p.m., while officers were on patrol around N. 9th Ave and Bridge St., they noticed a wanted individual. The male also noticed the police and hid in his mother's backyard. Officers were able to talk the male out of his hiding spot and safely take him into custody. The male had several felony warrants, including Motor Vehicle Theft and Failure to comply with Probation.
