SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 25-1049 : On Feb 26, at 4:45 p.m., officers were dispatched to the 800 block of S. 2nd Avenue regarding a disturbance. Officers learned that an 18-year-old male pointed and threatened a firearm at his neighbor. The neighbor feared for their safety and called the police for help. Officers arrived, and while taking the male into custody, he kicked and spit at the officers. He was later booked into the Adams County Jail on charges of felony menacing and other charges.

Case Report 25-1055: On Feb. 27, at 1:07 a.m., officers were dispatched to the 800 block of Sunflower Drive on a stabbing. Upon arrival, officers found an 18-year-old male covered in blood and bleeding from a cut on his hand. The male was intoxicated and couldn't tell officers where he was coming from. Officers followed a blood trail and located where the disturbance had occurred. They spoke to the homeowners, who identified the 18-year-old as a family member. They explained the male was intoxicated and, during an argument with one of the homeowners, armed himself with a pair of kitchen shears. The male attempted to stab the homeowner, and the homeowner wrestled the shears away from the male. During the struggle, the male cut himself and also cut one of the homeowners (non-life threatening cut). The male was arrested and booked into the Adams County Jail on 2nd Degree Assault charges.

Case Report 25-1062 : On Feb. 27 at 5:38 p.m., officers received information about a wanted party at Bridge Square Apartments, 90 S. 18th Ave. When the wanted suspect saw the police arrive, he ran but was quickly captured and taken into custody. The male was booked into Adams County Jail on his warrant and for violating three different protection orders that prohibited him from being at the apartment complex.

Case Report 25-1098 : On Mar. 1, at 7:00 p.m., officers responded to the intersection of S. 35th Ave and Eagle Blvd on a motorcycle and SUV crash. The motorcycle was traveling eastbound on Eagle Blvd, and the SUV was traveling southbound on S. 35th Ave crossing Eagle Blvd. to enter the Prairie Center. The motorcycle collided with the right front passenger door of the SUV. The preliminary investigation shows that the SUV failed to yield right away to the motorcycle. The motorcyclist sustained serious bodily injury and remains in critical condition. A passenger in the SUV suffered a fractured pelvis as a result of the crash. The Traffic Safety Unit continues to investigate this crash.

Case Report 25-1096 : On Mar. 1, at approximately 5:50 p.m., while on patrol near the 1600 block of Bridge St., officers spotted a group of males loitering behind the shopping center. As officers approached the males, the group quickly split up and attempted to get away from the officers. The officers contacted two of the males; one was found to have an active warrant for his arrest, and the second was found to be in possession of 2 grams of suspected methamphetamine. Both males were arrested.
