SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 25-1130: On Mar 4, at approximately 11:20 p.m., officers were dispatched to a gas station on a suspicious incident. The clerk reported that a young teenager had driven themselves to the gas station. Police located the vehicle and attempted to stop it. The driver failed to stop, disregarding the officers' attempts to get the driver to stop. Officers have identified the young teenager and will be investigating further. Child services were also notified of the report.

Case Report 25-1167 : On Mar. 6 at 8:40 a.m., officers were dispatched to 1141 Cardinal Avenue regarding a trespass. The residence had been declared uninhabitable by the Building Inspector after a search warrant in February. Neighbors reported seeing several vehicles coming and going and knew no one was supposed to be there. Officers contacted a 36-year-old-male inside the house. He said he knew he was not supposed to be there. He had already been arrested for trespassing there, CR#25-1023. He was arrested again and booked into ACDF on trespassing charges.

Case Report 25-1171 : On Mar. 6 at 10:15 a.m., a Traffic Safety Officer conducted a traffic stop for a motorcycle traveling 65mph in a 25mph construction zone. The 30-year-old-male did not have a motorcycle endorsement, had no insurance for the past year, and had not registered the vehicle. He was issued a summons, and the motorcycle was towed.

Case Report 25-1183 : On Mar. 6 at 6:40 p.m., Officers were conducting extra patrols at Motel 85. They located a stolen vehicle, a blue 2005 Chevrolet Silverado from Denver, parked near room 10. The plate had been altered to disguise it. They were able to contact the resident, a 34 year-old-male, through the window of the room. After the positive ID, they found he had a felony warrant out of Denver Sheriff's Office for motor vehicle theft. After two hours of negotiation and OC exposure, the male gave up and came out of the room. He was taken to the hospital for medical clearance for jail and then to the Adams County Jail.

Case Report 25-1220 : On Mar. 9, at 4:00 a.m., Brighton Gas, located at 601 S. Main St, was burglarized. The owner reported the burglary later in the morning when they arrived at the business. This was the second night in a row the gas station was burglarized. After reviewing the video surveillance, the officers developed a suspect in the case. Both cases have been assigned to the investigations division.
