### SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

**Case Report 25-1252** : On Mar. 11, at approximately 10:00 a.m., officers were dispatched to check wellbeing at the Adams County Justice Center. Officers were asked to check on two individuals who appeared to be under the influence of narcotics. One individual in particular was slumped over a landscaping boulder. Officers contacted the individuals and found one of them, a 35 year-old-male, in possession of suspected powder fentanyl and other narcotics. The male was arrested and later booked into the Adams County Jail.

**Case Report 25-1337** : On Mar. 13, at 2:30 a.m., officers were dispatched to an unconscious party at a residence near Denver St. and Midland St. Officers found an unconscious 45-year-old male, not breathing and without a pulse. Officers Hernandez and Bishop began CPR until medical personnel arrived and took over life-saving measures. The male was later transported by ambulance to the hospital with a pulse. It is unknown what caused the medical episode.

**Case Report 25-1366** : On Mar. 14 at 2:58 p.m., officers received information that a child was left alone in a vehicle parked in the parking lot of the police department. Officers checked the parking lot and found the vehicle with a five-year-old girl alone. Officers checked the camera and found the child had been left in the parking by her father, who was attending court for two hours. The father was arrested and booked into the Adams County Jail on charges of child abuse. The child was turned over to her mother.

**Case Report 25-1358**: On Mar. 14 at 12:30 a.m., officers were on patrol when they contacted a vehicle for registration violations. Officers found the vehicle unregistered and uninsured, and the driver did not have a valid driver's license. The driver also displayed indicators of drug impairment. The driver was arrested on traffic charges and possession of drug paraphernalia. The passenger was also arrested and charged with being in possession of suspected fentanyl.

**Case Report 25-1360**: On Mar. 14 at 2:13 a.m., officers were dispatched on reports of 10 people fighting at Main Bar and Karaoke, 20 North Main Street, and a male had a gun. Officers arrived as a 40-year-old intoxicated male crouched down behind an SUV as people were pointing out that he had a gun. Officers put the male at gunpoint, and he surrendered. The male threw his loaded .380 handgun under the SUV, and officers recovered it. Before the officer's arrival, they learned that the intoxicated male was threatening people with the firearm. He was arrested and later booked into Adams County Jail on multiple charges.

**Case Report 25-1377**: On Mar. 15, at 12:40 a.m., officers responded to a residence on Elm Ave on reports of gunshot wound. Officers found a resident who accidentally shot himself while unloading the firearm. Officers applied a tourniquet to help stop the bleeding. The individual was transported to the hospital and is expected to be okay.


