SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 25-1444 : On Mar. 17, at 7:40 p.m., Officers responded to a crash at the intersection of Denver St. and N. 10th Ave. involving a pedestrian on an electric skateboard and a truck. The skateboarder was northbound on N. 10th Ave, and the truck was westbound on Denver St., which had the right-of-way when it struck the skateboarder. The rider of the skateboard sustained serious injuries. The driver of the truck remained on scene and has been fully cooperative with the investigation. The preliminary stages of the investigation show that the skateboarder did not stop at the stop sign. Speed or alcohol do not appear to be contributing factors to this crash. Case Report 25-1479 : On Mar. 17, at 1:17 p.m., officers responded to an unwanted person at Daveco Liquors, 2555 Prairie Center Parkway. When officers arrived, they found a store employee attempting to detain a 30-year-old male who was seated in the driver's seat of the vehicle. The male showed signs of being intoxicated and began fighting police, throwing a bottle of liquor on an officer. Officers had to use a taser on the male to gain his compliance and place him into police custody. The individual did not sustain any injuries. During the subsequent investigations, officers learned the employee's foot had been run over during this encounter with this individual. He was charged with Resisting Arrest, Careless Driving causing Injury, DUI, and other charges. After a medical clearance, he was booked into Adams County Jail.

Case Report 25-1508 : On Mar. 20, at 6:00 p.m., officers responded to the 900 block of Skeel St. on reports of people breaking into an abandoned house. Officers found a juvenile male and female inside the house. The female ran from the residence but was arrested a short distance from the house. Both were arrested on burglary charges. The on-call streets department assisted the police department in boarding up the house.

Case Report 25-1521 : On Mar. 21, at 1:00 p.m., officers received reports of an underage Brighton resident befriending an adult male from Iowa. The two had conversations over the course of several weeks. The male flew into Denver with the intent to have sex with the underage Brighton resident. Officers were able to gather enough evidence to arrest the adult male and book him into the Adams County Jail on charges of Internet Luring.

Case Report 25-1538: On Mar. 22, at 1:30 p.m., officers were dispatched to Anythink Library, 327 E. Bridge St., on a disturbance. Officers contacted two adult females, both in their 30s, fighting over their boyfriend. One of the females is currently dating the male, and the other recently broke up with the male. The current girlfriend threatened the ex-girlfriend with a 7-inch knife. She was arrested on felony menacing charges.
