SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 25-1714: On March 31, 2025, at 11:05 a.m., while conducting proactive patrol, officers developed probable cause to search a vehicle during a traffic stop. The following items were recovered; 7.4g of a substance containing Meth, 2.09g of heroin, 1.93 grams of a colored powder containing fentanyl, 1.59g crack cocaine, and 0.99g Ecstasy. The driver, a 51-year-old male, and the passenger, a 47-year-old female, were both arrested and booked into the Adams County Jail for unlawful possession of a controlled substance.

Case Report 25-1771: On Apr. 2, 2025, at 12:32 p.m., officers were dispatched to Highway 85 and Bromley Lane for a crash involving a semi and two other passenger vehicles. Traffic at the intersection was slowing, and the semi-trailer driver did not slow in time, causing it to crash with two vehicles at the intersection. No injuries were reported. The driver of the semi-trailer was cited for careless driving.

Case Report 25-1779: On Apr. 2, 2025, at 3:40 p.m., officers were contacted by a male and his brother who reported a road rage incident that turned into a felony menacing near I-76 and Bridge St. The brothers reported being aggressively followed by a vehicle, and when they stopped at the intersection the suspect excited his vehicle and pointed a gun in their direction. Officers were able to determine where the suspect lived and found the gun in his vehicle. The gun that was used was a fake gun, but it appeared very similar to a real weapon. The suspect, a 38-year-old from Lochbuie, was booked into the Adams County Jail on charges of felony menacing.

Case Report 25-1836: On Apr. 5 at 8:00 p.m., an officer on patrol near Southern St. and S. 29th Avenue saw a male and female engaged in an altercation. The officer saw the male push the female. When the officer approached the couple, the male ran from the police. Officers learned that the couple were a boyfriend/girlfriend couple, and the male was angry at the female. Officers were able to eventually find the male and arrest him for assault and domestic violence.

Case Report 25-1837: On Apr. 5 at 9:45 p.m., while officers were searching for the suspect in the above case. One of the patrol vehicles was struck by a suspected drunk driver near Southern St. and S. 27th Ave.

The driver, a 74-year-old male from Northglenn, initially fled the scene but was contacted a short distance away from the crash. He was arrested and booked into the Adams County Jail on charges of DUI and Hit and Run.
