### SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

**Case Report 25-1890:** On April 9<sup>th</sup>, at 12:04 a.m., officers were dispatched to Interstate 76 near East 168<sup>th</sup> Avenue and a request to cover detectives with the Colorado Metropolitan Auto Theft Task Force on a stop. One of the occupants fled the scene, and they were requesting officers to assist with the apprehension. The 30-year-old male was arrested, and BPD officers assisted with the transport to Adams County Detention Facility (ACDF).

**Case Report 25-1891:** On April 9<sup>th</sup>, at 8:30 a.m., School Resource Officers (SROs) received information about a school threat for Overland Trail Middle School. The police and the school worked closely together as they investigated the threat, and the police heightened school security throughout the week. **Case Report 25-1929:** On April 10<sup>th</sup> at 3:45 p.m., officers were dispatched to Safeway, 1605 East Bridge Street, for a shoplift in progress. A 47-year-old female and a 35-year-old female pushed out two carts full of goods without paying. They were contacted while loading the stolen goods into a vehicle with two young children, 1 and 3 years old. They took over \$1,300 worth of items. Both females were arrested.

**Case Report 25-1963:** On April 12<sup>th</sup>, at 11:08 a.m., a crash occurred at W. Bromley Ln and S. Main St. The driver of the car turned north onto S. Main St from Bromley. The motorcycle was traveling westbound on Bromley. The motorcyclist was thrown from the motorcycle and transported to Platte Valley Medical Center with possible arm fractures. The Traffic Unit is still investigating.

**Case Report 25-1956:** On April 13<sup>th</sup>, at 1:18 a.m., officers were dispatched to an iPhone crash notification located in the area of WCR31 and WCR4. It was later determined that two vehicles had crashed in the intersection, ejecting the drivers of both vehicles. One party was found to have been thrown from a Chevy 3500, who was still conscious but in extreme pain. The driver of the other vehicle, a 17-year-old female, was found unconscious several yards away. The investigation determined the female driver was traveling northbound on WCR31 and failed to stop at the stop sign at WCR4. When she entered the intersection, the second vehicle T boned the at-fault vehicle. Neither the drivers nor the

passengers were wearing seatbelts. Both parties sustained serious injuries. Alcohol and drugs appear to be contributing factors in this crash.

**Case Report 25-1994:** On April 13th, at 9:54 p.m., officers were dispatched to a structure fire in the 700 block of S. 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave. with Brighton Fire Rescue. The residential fire was discovered after the family returned home from picking up their children. The fire caused some damage to the kitchen, where the fire appears to have started. Heavy smoke damage reported. No one else was in the residence during or leading up to the time the fire started.

**Case Report 25-2027:** On April 15th, at 8:06 p.m., officers responded to a crash at S. 27<sup>th</sup> Ave & Kestrel St. A 41-year-old female rear-ended a vehicle while traveling north on S. 27th Ave. The driver of the rear-ended vehicle, a 41-year-old male, complained of neck pain and was transported to Platte Valley Medical Center. The female driver was arrested for DUI and careless driving, causing injury.
