SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 25-2010 : On April 14, at 4:00 p.m., officers were dispatched to the King Soopers, 100 N. 50th Ave on reports of a drunk driver. A female contacted Fire personnel who were at the store on an unrelated matter asking for help in locating her car. The firefighters noticed the female was displaying signs of intoxication and request police respond to investigate. Officers responded and contacted the 39-year-old woman and found she did appear to be intoxicated. She admitted to being intoxicated and driving her vehicle to the store. She was arrested and charged with DUI.

Case Report 20-2045 : On April 16th, at 4:45 p.m., swing shift officers on patrol near Longspeak St and N. 8th Ave recognized an individual known to have warrants for his arrest. The individual was contacted and found to have two active warrants for his arrest. Officers located 5.54 grams of suspected methamphetamine on the male's person.

Case Report 20-2052 : On April 16th, at 8:00 p.m., officers were dispatched to the Super Target, 2171 Prairie Center Parkway, on report of a shoplifter. Officers contacted the store's prevention officer who had a 75-year-old male detained after he attempted to steal over \$200 worth of merchandise. The male was also found to be in possession of .80 grams of suspected methamphetamine. He was arrested and later released on a summons to court.

Case Report 20-2067 : On April 17th, at 7:30 p.m., officers took a report of attempted sexual exploitation. The victim befriended an individual on a dating network. The two engaged in conversation, which led to the victim sending a nude photograph of themselves. The suspect then threatened the victim that if they didn't send money, the suspect would share the victim's photographs. Police warn the public of interacting with strangers on social media networks.
