SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 25-2313: On May 1st, at 5:27 p.m., officers were dispatched to an injury crash at East Bridge Street and North 18th Avenue. Officers found out, through a citizen's dashcam, that a black Audi A4 was traveling westbound on East Bridge Street, weaving through traffic. The vehicle was traveling about 50mph in a 30mph zone. After weaving through traffic, the Audi rear-ended a Mitsubishi Mirage. The Audi lost control and demolished the donation box in the Safeway parking lot before coming to a stop. The occupants fled the scene, but officers located them soon after.

Case Report 25-2327: On May 2nd, at 10:17 a.m., officers were dispatched to a crash involving a vehicle and a pedestrian in front of the Brighton Oasis Water Park. The pedestrian, an individual who is 17 years old, was riding his electric scooter through the intersection when a vehicle ran a red light and collided with him. The vehicle was driven by a 47-year-old female. The pedestrian was transported to the Platte Valley Medical Center by ambulance and had a broken foot. The female was charged with Careless Driving causing Injury.

Case Report 25-2365: On May 4th, at 2:35 a.m., Officers responded to a rollover crash near S. 27th Ave and Purcell St. The driver, a 45-year-old male, was northbound on S. 27th Ave when he crashed into the median near Jessup St. The collision caused the vehicle to roll and land near Purcell St. The driver displayed evidence of being intoxicated and transported to the hospital with minor injuries. He was issued a summons for DUI, Careless Driving, and No Insurance.

Case Report 25-2384: On May 5th, at 6:37 a.m., Officers responded to a 3-motor vehicle crash on Southbound HWY 85/ North of Bromley Ln. Vehicles were blocking traffic, and white smoke was coming from one of the vehicles involved, but there were no flames. One driver had an injury on their forehead due to hitting their face. Southbound HWY 85 was shut down during the investigation for about 20 minutes. One driver was transported to Platte Valley Medical Center.

Case Report 25- 2398: On May 5th, 10:45 p.m., Officers on patrol near S. 18th Ave/ Bridge ST. located an occupied stolen vehicle. Officers conducted a high-risk stop and took a 38-year-old male and a 51-year-old female into custody without incident. Officers located several likely stolen items inside the vehicle, including 4 laptops, 12 cell phones, and other miscellaneous items. Officers also located a loaded firearm, fentanyl, and paraphernalia inside the vehicle. Both occupants were booked into ACDF. Detective notified.
