SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 25-2420: Felony Menacing- Disorderly- Harassment- 895 S Kuner Rd: On May 6th, at 11:31 p.m., Officers were dispatched to a disturbance involving a male party throwing items at employees after being asked to leave due to the dinner area being closed to the public. Prior to law enforcement arriving, the party began threatening staff with a knife. The male party, a 37-year-old male, became upset with the staff after being asked to leave. The male threw items at the employees and swung the knife at another employee. The male then approached the employee, who backed up and told the rest of the employees to hide in the kitchen area and to call 9-11. He left the premises before officers arrived on the scene. Officers were able to locate the male in the parking lot, where a pocketknife/blade was located on him. He was taken into custody without incident and later transported to Adams County Detention Facility. The VA and on-call detective were notified.

Case Report 25-2456: On May 8th, at 4:26 p.m., Ofc. Covarrubias IV performed a traffic stop on a suspected DUI party, a 42-year-old male, who had swerved into oncoming traffic as Ofc. Covarrubias activated his lights. After stopping, the male slowly backed into Ofc. Covarrubias's push bumper, then slowly drove off. After a few blocks, the male stopped again, and Ofcs. Covarrubias and Robinson used their vehicles to stop the male from driving away again. The male was arrested for felony DUI, among other charges, and transported to Adams County Detention Facility.

Case Report 25-2496: Officers spotted a known offender with an active warrant for his arrest. The suspect fled from officers but was captured after a brief foot chase. The male was arrested and booked on his warrants.
