SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 25-2487: On May 10th, at about 5:20 p.m., an Officer on proactive patrol in the area of S. Main St and Jessup St. recognized a 49-year-old male who was wanted on arrest warrants. The male attempted to run from the officer and took a fighting stance. The male was tased before being taken into custody and later booked into the Adams County Jail on the warrants and new charges of possession of drug paraphernalia and resisting arrest.

Case Report 25-2496: On May 11th, at about 8:30 a.m., officers on proactive patrol in the area of N. Main St. and Strong St. recognized a 37-year-old male wanted on an arrest warrant. The male ran from officers and was caught about a block away. The male was taken into custody and later booked into the Adams County Jail on the active warrant.

Case Report 25-2592: On May 15th, at about 7:45 p.m., officers were dispatched to the 200 block S. 22nd Ave on reports of a felony menacing stemming from a verbal argument. A 24-year-old male was to have a pistol on his waistband. The male had a previous weapons conviction and was on probation, making it illegal for him to have a firearm on his person. He was arrested for possession of a weapon by a previous offender charge and booked into the Adams County Jail.

Case Report 25-2590: On May 15th, at 5:05 p.m., officers were dispatched to a residence in the 3000 Block of Bridge Street on reports of an unconscious male. Responding officers found a male suffering from stab wounds; he later died at the hospital due to the injuries he sustained. This is an active investigation: [News Release](#)

Case Report 25-2615: On May 16th, at 7:00 p.m., officers on proactive patrol near Main St and Bromley Lane conducted a traffic stop. The driver was found to have a revoked driver's license. The driver was arrested for driving on a revoked license and found to be in possession of over 2 grams of methamphetamine.
