SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 25-2678: On May 19, at approximately 6:46 p.m., officers were dispatched to Target to investigate a shoplifting. Officers contacted two adult males who were attempting to steal over \$300 worth of merchandise. Both were arrested and issued summonses.

Case Report 25-2781: On May 19 at approximately 5:00 p.m., Officers were dispatched to 385 Bromley Lane on reports of two males involved with illegal drug activity. Officers contacted the individuals and found methamphetamine on one of the males. He also had an active warrant out of Jefferson County. The male was arrested on drug charges and a warrant.

Case Report 25-2777: On May 23rd, at about 3:30 p.m., officers were dispatched to a crash at 18th Ave. and East Bridge St. A 65-year-old female was driving northbound from East Bridge St. on 18th Ave. She hit a vehicle that was traveling southbound, crossed southbound traffic, jumped the curb, hit a yellow pylon, then crossed back over across northbound traffic, before driving her car up onto the sidewalk and coming to rest against the Napa Auto Parts. She displayed signs of being intoxicated and was found to be a revoked habitual traffic offender (HTO). She was arrested and booked into Adams County Detention Facility.

Case Report 25-2810: On May 24th, at about 1:30 a.m., officers were dispatched to 90 S. 18th Ave to a disturbance in progress. Officers were called to the parking lot on a report of multiple people fighting. When officers arrived on the scene, they learned that several people wearing masks came out of an apartment in building D and demanded a female to go with them and showed a gun. The female was able to get away and was safe. The suspects are unknown at this time.

Case Report 25-2855: On May 28th, at about 10:30 p.m., officers were dispatched to Phoenix Apartments to assist on an overdose call. A 35-year-old male was overdosing on fentanyl in the rear parking lot. The male's girlfriend had already administered naloxone (a drug used to treat opioid overdoses) before officer arrival. Officer Garrow also assisted in deploying an additional dose of naloxone. Shortly thereafter, paramedics arrived on the scene and provided further medical intervention. As a result, the male regained consciousness. The male had ingested a combination of fentanyl and alcohol. His girlfriend expressed concern that he may continue to use dangerous substances, further risking his health and safety. For the male's wellbeing, he was taken to the hospital for further treatment.
