SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 25-2870: On May 28th, at approximately 5:11 p.m., Officers responded to a residence on N. 13th Ave on a repeat 9-1-1 call. The 22-year-old male had made over 200 false 9-1-1 calls during a two-week span. As officers were trying to take the individual into custody, he began fighting with officers, striking an officer in the mouth. The individual was arrested and booked into the Adams County Jail.

Case Report 25-2887: On May 29th, at about 1:52 p.m., officers were dispatched to a vehicle trespass in the 1100 block of Walnut St. The homeowner left his vehicle unlocked while he ran inside for a few minutes; when he returned, he found someone had entered his vehicle and stole his wallet. His credit card was used a short time later at a liquor store in Brighton. Officers responded to the liquor store and reviewed the video surveillance, recognizing the suspect as a 53-year-old male. Officers responded to the suspect's address, contacted the male, and found the stolen wallet. The suspect was arrested and booked into Adams County Detention Facility.

Case Report 25-2935: On May 29th, at about 4:00 p.m., officers conducting proactive patrols in the area of S. 4th Ave and Jessup St. stopped a vehicle that displayed expired plates. The driver of the vehicle was found to have a suspended license and no valid insurance for the vehicle. The officers' investigations also found the driver to be in possession of drug paraphernalia and over 3 grams of a crystal-like substance suspected to be methamphetamine.

Case Report 25-2968: On June 2nd, at about 12:30 p.m., officers were dispatched to a residence in the 3000 block of E. Bridge St., on reports of a 25-year-old male unconscious and not breathing on a drug overdose. The officers quickly arrived, administered a dose of naloxone (a drug used to treat known or possible opioid overdoses), and began CPR. Fire personnel arrived shortly after, and the male regained a pulse and was transported to the hospital for treatment.
