### SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

**Case Report 25-3044:** On June 5th, at around 7:00 pm, Officers were dispatched to a fire in the area of 114th Avenue and Peoria Street. A neighbor observed an ATV catch fire as well as the fence. Fortunately, it was raining and the fire was put out. No damage to structures.

**Case Report 25-3060:** On June 5th, at around 3:30 pm, Community Services Officers and Patrol Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of E. Bromley Lane on a CO2 alarm. Brighton Fire Rescue requested the Brighton Police Department to respond after seeing an unusually large amount of animal feces and urine. During the course of the investigation, it is discovered the home has more than 4 dogs as allowed by municipal code. City Building Inspectors respond and condemn the house for human habitation.

**Case Report 25-3051:** On June 6th, at around 7:10 am, Officers were dispatched to an unconscious/not responsive 42-year-old male lying in front of 7-11, located at 1012 East Bridge Street, with difficulty breathing. Ofc. Thomas and Ofc. Hathaway started CPR and gave him 2 doses of Narcan. When paramedics arrived, the male had a pulse and was transported to Platte Valley Medical Center.

**Case Report 25-3057:** On June 6th, at around 1:00 pm, Officers were dispatched to a disturbance with three people intoxicated, walking in the street by Egbert Street and South 12th Avenue. Officers contacted a 50-year-old male, who was uncooperative. They found he had active warrants for his arrest and while with him on scene he was sweating profusely. Officers called for paramedics to respond, and they transported him to Platte Valley Medical Center. After a medical clearance for jail, he was transported to the Brighton Police Department. While in the booking area, he ran his head into the corner of the concrete wall, causing a significant head injury. He was transported back to Platte Valley Medical Center by paramedics. After being medically treated, he was booked into Adams County Jail.

**Case Report 25-3142:** On June 10th, at around 2:15 pm, Officers were dispatched on a request from Detectives from Safe Streets to attempt to contact a suspect they were surveilling for attempt murder, kidnapping, and sexual assault out of Colorado Springs. Officers spotted the suspect in the 1300 block E Bridge and gave chase. After a short foot pursuit, the suspect was taken into custody without incident. The suspect was a 25-year-old Brighton man.
