SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case report 25-3187: On June 12th, at around 6:00 pm, Officers were requested to assist with a structure fire near 138th Avenue and Riverdale Road. A house was on fire and there were possibly two elderly people who were trapped. Officers arrived quickly to find a large garage, remodeled to have several apartments, fully engulfed in flames. A male was seen fleeing after the fire and was contacted by Brighton Officers. He was arrested for warrants and possible involvement. There were seven people who were possibly inside when the fire occurred. Two were later accounted for but the Fire Department had to back away as the roof collapsed. Brighton was relieved by other officers from Thornton Police Department and Adams County Sheriff's Office.

Case report 25-3213: On June 14th, at around 2:00 am, Officers were dispatched to a physical fight outside Jordinelli's Bar, at 25 North Main Street. When Officers arrived on scene they were directed to a vehicle, 2011 Ford Escape, fleeing the scene. Another vehicle, a silver Ford Focus, was also seen leaving and an Officer attempted a traffic stop. The vehicle failed to yield, driving quickly away on Highway 85 and the Officer discontinued the pursuit. The other vehicle seen leaving was traveling eastbound in the westbound lanes of traffic on East Bridge Street in a reckless manner. As another Officer was responding to the fight, he found the vehicle as it moved over to the correct lanes and conducted a traffic stop. The front passenger, a 26-year-old female, admitted to being in a fight and losing. She had visible injuries and after medical treatment she was issued a summons for Disorderly Conduct. The female's brother, a 28-year-old, was driving and intoxicated. He was arrested for DUI/Reckless Driving/Failed to Stop at Stop Sign among other traffic charges. He was booked into the Adams County Detention Facility.

Case report 25-3215: On June 14th, at around 3:30 am, Officers were dispatched to twenty to thirty juveniles trespassing at the pool at 3128 Eagle Boulevard. When the officers arrived on scene they scattered over the fences. The officers caught three adults and four juveniles, and they were charged with trespassing.

Case report 25-3272: On June 17th, around 9 a.m., Officers received an alert on a wanted party out of Broomfield on allegations of sexual assault. Officers worked together to determine that the suspect, a 40-year-old male, lives here in Brighton. They were able to contact his wife, who agreed to return to the

house, where she said the suspect was sleeping, and had him go outside. He was arrested without incident. He was later booked into the Adams County Detention Facility.
