SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 25-3245: On June 16th, at about 4:00 a.m., officers were dispatched to a crash on I-76 near Buckley Road. Officers found that a single vehicle had been involved in a crash. The driver, a 21-year-old male, was uninjured but displayed signs of being intoxicated and believed he was in Denver. The driver was arrested for suspicion of driving under the influence of alcohol. The driver was also found to be in possession of suspected to be methamphetamine. The driver was later booked into the Adams County Jail on related charges.

Case Report 25-3283: On June 17th, at about 4:20 p.m., officers were dispatched to Target located at 2171 Prairie Center Parkway on a report of a shoplift. Upon arrival, officers learned that a frequent shoplifter known to the store had just attempted to steal a large amount of merchandise totaling over \$2,500. The loss prevention agent reported to officers that the same shoplifter and her associates had been apprehended at an Aurora Target for stealing there. Brighton Officers were able to confirm the identity of the offender and are in the process of filing for an arrest warrant.

Case report 25-3348: On June 21st, at around 2:30 a.m., Officers were dispatched to an unconscious female lying at a table outside of Jack in the Box, 64 West Bromley Lane. The 45-year-old female was not responsive, so an Officer began CPR. After several minutes, the female regained consciousness and Brighton Fire Rescue transported her to Platte Valley Medical Center.

Case Report 25-3359: On June 21st, at about 4:23 p.m., officers were made aware of a video circulating on social media where a female was seen screaming in a vehicle and trying to get out. Later in the day, the offender in the video, a 26-year-old male, called the police department to let officers know he was the male in the video. Officers completed an investigation and ultimately arrested the male on several charges related to domestic violence.

Case Report 25-3364: On June 21st at 9:18 p.m. officers responded to a vehicle vs. motorcycle crash in the area of Egbert St and 10th Ave. On scene investigation determined the motorcyclist, a 29-year-old

male was traveling in excess of 70 mph when he struck the side of a vehicle crossing Egbert at S 10th Ave. The motorcyclist was seriously injured. The Traffic Safety Unit responded to investigate.
