SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case report 25-3745: On July 9th, at around 1:30 a.m., officers on patrol spotted a vehicle near South 45th Ave and Bridge St with the rear tail lights out. When the driver of the vehicle did not stop at a stop sign, officers initiated a traffic stop. The driver, a 21-year-old female, was slurring her words and had glassy/watery eyes when responding to questions from the officer. These behaviors are consistent with DUI. She was arrested for DUI, and a breath test showed that her Breath Alcohol Content was above the legal limit of .08. She was booked into Adams County Detention Facility on traffic charges and DUI.

Case report 25-3751: On July 9th, at around 10:45 a.m., Community Services Officers (CSO) responded to an animal welfare check near the 100 block of South Cabbage Ave. The caller reported that there was a dog left unattended in a parked vehicle. CSO's were able to safely get the dog out of the vehicle, into the CSO truck, and transported it to the Riverdale Animal Shelter for further care and evaluation. Officers also found a deceased dog in the back of the vehicle; the cause of death is under investigation. The owner of the car and dogs was identified. This is an ongoing case.

Case report 25-3790: On July 11th, at around 8:40 a.m., officers were dispatched to the 600 block of South Main Street on a call for a 28-year-old male who was unconscious and not responding. Brighton Fire Rescue and Paramedics were already on scene when officers arrived to assist. Brighton Fire had given the male a dose of Narcan. After the medication was administered, the male regained consciousness and was transported to Platte Valley Medical Center for further treatment.

Case report 25-3804: On July 11th, at around 6 p.m., officers were dispatched to an Auto/Pedestrian crash at East Egbert Street and South 5th Avenue. A juvenile female was riding her bicycle southbound on South 5th Avenue. A 49-year-old woman was driving westbound on East Egbert Street. Witnesses observed the juvenile female enter the intersection without slowing down. She was struck by the vehicle and sustained serious injuries. She was transported to the Hospital and is in serious but stable condition. The driver of the vehicle was cooperative and stayed on scene. The Brighton Police Department's Traffic Safety Unit responded to this crash, and they are investigating the scene. Our Victim Advocate team was called for the family and responded to the Hospital.

Case report 25-3821: On July 12th, at around 4:45 p.m., officers were dispatched to a kidnapping at the Brighton Sports Complex, 1111th Judicial Center Drive. Dispatch advised that a 13-year-old girl had been taken by an unknown person. When officers arrived, they were able to confirm that the juvenile female had left the Sports Complex with another juvenile. Officers used multiple resources and found that the alleged victim planned for the other underage girl to pick her up from the Sports Complex. Officers quickly learned the other girls' address and had the local police department waiting for the girls to arrive at her home. The 13-year-old girl was reunited with her family.

Case report 25-3822: On July 12th, at around 6:30 p.m., officers were dispatched to the block of 3000 Eagle Blvd. on a well-being call for an unconscious male in a parked vehicle. The 33-year-old male had fallen asleep in the driver's seat, and there was a child in the backseat of the vehicle asleep as well. When officers responded, they found that the male had fallen asleep as he was preparing to drive away from a family gathering. The male was slurring his words, had watery/bloodshot eyes, was confused, and had a strong alcohol smell from his breath and person. These behaviors are consistent with DUI. He was arrested on DUI and child abuse charges and booked into Adams County Detention Facility.
