SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 25-3986: On July 21st, at around 9:50 a.m., while on proactive patrol, officers recognized a 37-year-old male who was wanted on an active arrest warrant in the 100 block of W Bridge St. The male noticed the officers in their patrol car and immediately fled on foot. An officer chased the individual on foot and took him into custody a short time later. The male was booked and transported to the Adams County Detention Facility.

Case Report 25-3999: On July 21st, at around 4:40 p.m., officers responded to the 1000 block of E Bridge St on a report for fraud/forgery. When Officers arrived at the bank, they identified the individual, a 43-year-old female, who was attempting to withdraw a large amount of money from the bank using a lost/stolen driver's license. This driver's license was reported as lost/stolen from a victim living in Superior, Colorado. After further questioning, officers arrested the female for ID theft. She was transported to the Adams County Detention Facility.

Case Report 25-4064: On July 23rd, at around 8:00 a.m., officers responded to N. Main St at E. 168th Ave on a report of a person waving a knife and throwing debris in the roadway. Officers were able to identify a 44-year-old woman who was the individual reported. They observed her concealing the knife that she was carrying. After making contact, officers also found that she was in possession of fentanyl pills and suspected methamphetamine. She was arrested and booked into Adams County Detention Facility on the drug charges.

Case Report 25-4068: On July 23rd, at around 9:00 a.m., officers were on directed traffic enforcement in the area of the 2000 Block of Prairie Center Parkway when Officers made contact with a vehicle that had expired plates from March of 2024. The driver of the car was a 51-year-old male with a revoked license and didn't have insurance for the car. Dispatch confirmed that the male was a habitual traffic offender, and he was arrested for his traffic offenses. Additionally, the passenger who was in the vehicle, a 45-year-old male, had a warrant for his arrest. Officers also found a backpack on the floorboard of the passenger side with 15 grams of suspected methamphetamine. Both the driver and the passenger were booked into the Adams County Detention Facility on their individual offenses and drug charges.

Case report 25-4212: On July 30th, at 4:00 a.m., officers responded to a business alarm activation at Signal Wash Co. Carwash at 4112 East Bromley Ln. When arriving on the scene, officers observed an open door to the office building. After securing the scene, the owner arrived and noticed that over \$2000 in cash and quarters was missing from the business. Store personnel provided police with video surveillance that showed the male pictured above entering and leaving the business with the money. This is an active investigation.
