SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case report 25-4324: On August 4th, at around 8:45 p.m., an officer responded to a rollover crash at Bridge St. and S 6th Ave involving three occupants. When the officer arrived on scene, they observed that one occupant of the vehicle, a 17-year-old female, had a minor facial injury. The occupant in the passenger seat, a 16-year-old female, informed Officers that she was not wearing her seat belt. The driver of the vehicle, an 18-year-old male, stated that he looked down at his phone for a brief moment when he veered to the right, striking the curb. He tried to correct his mistake, but the vehicle rolled over. Medical and Brighton Fire Rescue responded and transported those who were injured to Platte Valley Medical Center. The driver was cited for careless driving.

Case report 25-4326 / 25-4327: On August 5th, at around 2:30 a.m., Officers responded to a burglary in progress at Doobie's Smoke Shop, at 8 Great Western Rd. Suspects were observed on video by the store personnel attempting to break into the business. The suspects were scared off before they could break in and fled the area in a silver Honda just before officers arrived. A short time later, at around 2:45 a.m., officers responded to another burglary in progress at Bromley Liquors located at 843 S Kuner Rd. These same suspects referenced in the above case had rammed a black Hyundai into the store. The suspects entered the store and stole approximately \$600 in alcohol and \$2000 in vapes. The three suspects appeared to be young, Hispanic males who drove off in a silver Honda. The Hyundai used to crash into the store was left on scene and was reported stolen out of another jurisdiction. Brighton Detectives were notified, and both cases are under investigation.

Case Report 25-4431: On August 9th, at around 4:30 p.m., officers responded to a crash involving a vehicle running over a stop sign in the 100 block of Cherry Place. A silver truck was traveling south on South 2nd Avenue when the driver, a 25-year-old male, collided with a flatbed trailer parked on the roadway. It launched the trailer into the front yard of a house down the street. When the driver attempted to drive off in his vehicle, he collided with a large boulder and a stop sign. Officers approached the driver when he exited his car and the driver informed officers that he had been consuming alcohol. A firearm was also found in the vehicle. He was arrested and booked into the Adams County Detention Facility on DUI/Prohibited Use of a Weapon charges.
