SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 25-5049: On September 9th, at around 1:15 p.m., officers responded to the 500 block of South 3rd Ave to a call for an infant not breathing for an unknown reason. Community Services Officer Mendoza (CSO) happened to be in the area, so he was the first person to arrive at the house and immediately began CPR on the infant. CSO Mendoza got the child breathing again just before the medics arrived. Medical took over and transported the baby to a nearby hospital that provided further care and evaluation. We are very thankful for CSO Mendoza's quick response!

Case Report 25-5062: On September 10th, at around 9:45 a.m., our officers responded with the Adams County Sheriff's Office to a stolen vehicle that was found at the Murphy Express, 79 West Bromley Lane. Earlier in the day, the Commerce City Police Department (CCPD) took the report for a stolen vehicle, and four juveniles were seen driving away in it. There were five occupants who were detained at the gas station. CCPD came to recover the car and arrest the driver.

Case Report 25-5101: On September 11th, at around 5:25 p.m., officers responded to a motorcycle crash at Bromley Lane and Fulton Avenue. The male rider, a 44-year-old male, was driving eastbound on Bromley Lane at Fulton when a vehicle made a left turn in front of the motorcycle, causing the collision. The male was not wearing a helmet and landed on the asphalt. He was transported to Platte Valley Medical Center with serious injuries, and he was later transported to Lutheran Hospital. The driver of the vehicle remained on scene and was cooperative with the investigation. The Traffic Safety Unit (TSU) is investigating this crash.

Case Report 25-5102: On September 11th, at around 6:30 p.m., officers responded to a disturbance with weapons at City Hall, 500 South 4th Avenue. A family was approached by a male in a motorized wheelchair who began yelling at one of the adults. The male was told to go away, but he instead pulled out a knife and was making stabbing motions towards the adult. The family quickly left the parking lot. The case is being investigated.

Case Report 25-5106: On September 11th, at around 10:00 p.m., officers responded to Arby's, 15190 Brighton Road, on a call for a suspicious male. The call said that he was stumbling through the drive-thru, yelling at employees, and knocking on the window of the business. Officer Contreras responded to the call and found him near the Quality Inn. The male, who was identified as 37-year-old Richard Turpin, threw a cigarette butt

collector, striking the patrol car. He then assumed a fighting stance when Ofc. Contreras exited the patrol vehicle. Ofc. Contreras put him at taser point and ordered him to the ground. He didn't comply, and another officer safely detained Turpin by putting him in handcuffs. While officers were placing him in the back of the patrol car, he turned and spit in Ofc. Contreras' face. He was taken straight to Adams County Detention Facility and booked into jail on multiple charges.

Case Report 25- 5125: On September 12th, at around 5:40 p.m., officers responded to a motorcycle crash at U.S. Highway 85 north of West Bromley Lane. The motorcyclist, a 21-year-old male, was riding his bike through traffic and splitting the lanes. A 66-year-old male driver was changing lanes when the motorcyclist collided with his vehicle. The motorcyclist sustained serious injuries and was transported to Platte Valley Medical Center. The Traffic Safety Unit is investigating this crash.
