SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case report 25-5849 : On October 21st, 2025, at around 11:45 a.m., our officers responded to the 500 block of S 2nd Ave for an armed carjacking. The victim was confronted by the suspect, who threatened the victim with a knife and assaulted her before taking her vehicle. The suspect crashed the vehicle a short distance away at E Bromley Lane and 2nd Ave. Officers conducted an extensive search for the suspect and followed up on all leads before discontinuing the search. Case report 25-5886: On October 22nd, at around 4:00 p.m., officers responded to the 100 block of S Main St. on a call to individuals smoking fentanyl inside of a vehicle. When officers made contact with the occupants, they found a 57-year-old man in the driver's seat and a 47-year-old female in the passenger seat. Officers had the male perform roadside maneuvers and he did not pass the maneuvers as a sober person would have. Both of the occupants were arrested and taken into custody. During a probable cause search of the vehicle, officers located 2.01 grams of heroin underneath the driver's seat. The male was transported to Adams County Detention Facility on multiple charges. The woman was processed and released pending charges.

Case report 25-5914 : On October 24th, at around 10:15 a.m., the Impact Team located a stolen vehicle in the parking lot of 90 South Miller Avenue. The vehicle was secured and towed. Thornton PD was notified of this incident, since the vehicle was reported stolen from their city.

Case report 25-5922: On October 25th, at around 1:30 a.m., officers responded to an auto-pedestrian crash in the area of 880 South Main Street. The victim, a 29-year-old male, called to report he had been hit by a vehicle, and the vehicle fled the scene. When officers arrived on scene, the victim stated that he was walking northbound on South Main Street in the roadway when he heard tires squealing. A vehicle turned left onto South Main Street and the male was hit from behind by the vehicle. He was able to move himself out of the roadway and call for help. He sustained a broken leg and was transported to the hospital by medical personnel. This incident is currently being investigated.
