### SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

**Case report 25-6412:** On November 18th, at around 1:20 p.m., officers responded to Fire Station 51 at 425 South Main for a man blocking the fire bay with his motorcycle. When officers arrived, the suspect, a 58-year-old man, was uncooperative with officers, Co-Responders, and firefighters. At one point, the man jumped onto his motorcycle, was recklessly driving, doing wheelies down S Main St. This caused traffic to be blocked for several hours, the motorcyclist putting himself and others at risk. After all efforts to get him to comply were exhausted, our officers were able to remove the man from the bike and take him into custody. He was transported to the hospital for a medical clearance and then booked at Adams County Detention Facility on multiple charges.

**Case report 25-6450:** On November 20<sup>th</sup>, at around 5:20 p.m., our Impact Officers were notified by Target Asset Protection of a potential theft in progress at the Target Store, 2171 Prairie Center Pkwy. It was reported that a 38-year-old female pushed a cart full of items past the front bathrooms. Officers attempted to contact her as she was fleeing the store. She fled into Michaels, where she was caught. During the arrest, Officers located drugs in her possession. She was arrested and booked into the Adams County Detention Facility on drug and theft charges.

**Case report 25-6471:** On November 21<sup>st</sup>, at around 7:30 p.m., officers on proactive patrols conducted a traffic stop in the area of North 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue and East 168<sup>th</sup> Avenue. When contacting the driver, a 33-year-old woman, she gave a false name and was acting suspiciously. Our officers identified her and found two warrants for her arrest. She was also found with methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia. The woman was arrested and booked into the Adams County Detention Facility on multiple charges.
