SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case report 25-6511: On November 24th, at around 1:30 a.m., officers responded to a head-on collision in the area of Hwy 85 and CR 2. When officers arrived on scene, the driver of the at-fault vehicle, a 44-year-old male, had fled. The driver was later located hiding in some bushes nearby and taken into custody. He was transported to the hospital for a medical clearance, then released from police custody on a summons.

Case report 25-6514: On November 24th, at around 10:00 a.m., officers responded to a trespassing call at a house near the 700 block of Mockingbird St. The victim stated that an unknown female had gotten into their house and locked herself in a laundry room. When officers arrived, the 36-year-old female had barricaded herself inside a bedroom. Officers had to force their way into the bedroom to take the suspect into custody. The woman was taken directly to the Adams County Detention Facility due to her combativeness and booked on the above charges.

Case report 25-6549: On November 26th, at around 12:05 p.m., officers responded to a shoplifting at Ulta. They reported two Hispanic males, who are chronic shoplifters, came into the store and stole over \$1,500 worth of fragrances. Over \$68,000 in thefts have occurred by these individuals from 39 events. This incident is currently being investigated.

Case report 25-6617: On November 29th, at around 1:30 p.m., officers responded to a shoplifting at Target. A 47-year-old male was removing the security measures from a scooter. When he was contacted by Target's Loss Prevention team, he fled into the parking lot. Officers observed him getting into the back of a white Ford Fusion, which had a passenger in the front seat, a 46-year-old male. When officers contacted the suspect, they observed several backpacks filled with merchandise from Walmart, Daveco, Ross, Michaels, Home Depot, and Dick's Sporting Goods. Loss prevention contacted another shoplifter, a 47-year-old male, who was identified as the owner of the vehicle. The stolen items totaled \$2,431, and they were all returned to the various stores. All three males were booked into the Adams County Detention Facility on felony shoplifting and other related charges.
