### SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

**Case Report 25-6671:** On December 3rd, at around 3:40 a.m., officers responded to an injury crash in the area of East Bromley Lane near Picadilly Road. A vehicle, driven by a 28-year-old male, was heading westbound on East Bromley Lane when he lost control on the icy road. The second vehicle, driven by an 18-year-old male, was traveling eastbound and collided, T-bone, with the other vehicle. The younger male sustained a broken arm from the crash, and he was transported to Platte Valley Medical Center.

**Case Report 25-6690 :** On December 4th, at around 3:15 p.m., our officers were doing proactive enforcement in the area of North 9th Avenue and Longs Peak Street. The officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle with stolen plates. The driver, a 50-year-old woman, was driving without a license. When searching the car, officers located a meth pipe and 56.55 grams of methamphetamine with her. The woman was booked into Adams County Detention Facility on multiple drug charges, including Possession with intent to distribute and Controlled Substance Special Offender.

**Case Report 25-6696:** On December 4th, at around 6:05 p.m., officers responded to a rollover crash at North 8th Avenue and East Bridge Street. A vehicle, driven by a 19-year-old male, was traveling northbound on South 8th Avenue. After passing the intersection, the vehicle hit a metal grate and rolled onto its roof. A 10-month-old baby was secured in their car seat and didn't sustain any serious injuries. The driver of the vehicle was arrested for reckless driving, driving with a revoked license, and without insurance.

**Case Report 25- 6703 :** On December 5th, at around 9:10 a.m., officers responded to a 4-vehicle crash on U.S. Highway 85 and East 124th Avenue. A 49-year-old male driving a large traffic cone truck reported falling asleep at a red light and rear-ending the box truck ahead of him, causing a chain reaction with the two cars ahead of the box truck. No one was injured, but the box truck was damaged enough to need a heavy-duty tow truck to lift it off the truck that caused the crash.
