SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 26-0104: On January 6th, the Impact Team received a request from the FBI's Safe Streets Task Force for assistance with the arrest of a 64-year-old woman on five warrants. At around 2:30 p.m., the Impact Team responded to the 300 block of Cedar Ave and identified the woman at the address as their suspect. Before the woman could leave the scene, our officers were able to place her under arrest without any incident. There was another person at the residence, a 61-year-old woman, who had outstanding warrants. Our team ALSO found 13.99 grams of meth in her possession during the arrest! The two women were transported to the Adams County Detention Facility and booked on the warrants and other charges.

Case Report 26-0162: On January 10th, at around 4:15 p.m., our officers were conducting a traffic stop on a vehicle with an expired temporary registration. The driver of the vehicle, a 42-year-old male, was driving recklessly and fled from officers. Officers proactively patrolled an area that he is known to frequent. While in the area, officers were flagged down by a citizen who stated that there was someone in the backyard of a house in the 100 block of N. 5th Ave. Officers located the male and arrested him for eluding. He was later booked into Adams County Detention Facility on multiple traffic-related charges as well as Trespassing.

Case Report 26-0166: On January 10th, at around 9:40 p.m., officers responded to the area of I-76 Frontage Rd. and 152nd near the roundabout on a report of a single motor vehicle crash. It was reported that the vehicle rolled over about four times before coming to a stop on its wheels. When officers arrived on the scene, they confirmed that the vehicle rolled over a few times. The driver, a 23-year-old male, opened the car door and exited the vehicle with no injuries. After speaking with the male, he was found to be DUI and consented to a blood draw. He was later booked into the Adams County Detention Facility. The roadway was closed for an hour as officers responded to the crash.
