SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case Report 25-7185: On December 30th, at around 10:30 p.m., officers responded to a crash with injuries in the area of Southgate Boulevard and Foley Road. A tow truck driver, a 38-year-old male, was securing a vehicle while in the center lane facing south. A van, driven by a 46-year-old woman, was traveling northbound. The driver hit the male who was standing in the roadway. The male was transported to an area hospital with serious injuries. The female driver remained on scene and was cooperative with the officers. TSU responded and will handle the investigation.

Case Report 26-0021: On January 1st, at around 7:30 p.m., officers were on proactive patrols in the area of the 70 block of North 9th Avenue and saw a suspicious vehicle at a known drug house. The vehicle wasn't on scene long and left the house. Officers followed the vehicle and attempted a traffic stop, but the vehicle fled. The vehicle was located, and officers found a passenger of the vehicle in the Taco Bell at 920 E Bridge St. When officers approached the male, he was uncooperative and under the influence of an unknown substance. Officers went to detain him, and he began to swing his arms around. A taser was deployed, and the male was safely taken into custody. He was found to have 3 active warrants and two felonies with no bond. The male was taken to the hospital for a medical clearance and then transported to the Adams County Detention Facility.

Case Report 26-0066: On January 4th, at around 2:45 p.m., officers responded to a rollover crash in the area of S 8th Ave and E Bromley Ln. A sedan traveling westbound on Bromley Ln ran the red light, striking a truck that was turning northbound on S 8th Ave. The vehicle that was hit spun and landed on its side, flipping over before Officers responded. The driver of the truck was transported to the hospital for minor injuries. The sedan driver received a citation while on scene. Southbound S 8th Ave was shut down for an hour due to vehicles blocking the roadway.
