### SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

**Case report 26-0180:** On January 12<sup>th</sup>, at around 1:30 a.m., while on proactive patrols, our officers conducted a traffic stop in the area of S. 8<sup>th</sup> Ave and E Bromley Ln, for a driver who had made several traffic violations. When speaking with officers, the driver, a 26-year-old male, appeared to be heavily intoxicated. He refused to do roadside testing and breath testing. He was placed under arrest and taken to the Brighton Police Department for processing. The male was found to have three previous DUI convictions. Officers transported him to the Adams County Detention Facility, and he was booked on his felony DUI charge.

**Case report 26 -0194:** On January 12<sup>th</sup>, at around 4:20 p.m., our officers responded to a call for a DUI driver in the area of 60 W Bromley Ln. The vehicle of the DUI driver was located, and the officers were able to identify the driver, who was a 53-year-old male. The male appeared heavily intoxicated and refused roadside testing and a breath test. He was placed under arrest and found to have three previous convictions for DUI. Officers transported him to the Adams County Detention Facility, where he was booked on his felony DUI charge.

**Case report 25 -5584:** On January 14<sup>th</sup>, at around 4:30 p.m., the Impact Team was conducting surveillance in the area of the 70 block N. 9<sup>th</sup> Ave. when they observed a known suspect inside a parked, unregistered vehicle. When our officers made contact, the 33-year-old female suspect was taken into custody for CR 25-5584 for charges of possession with intent to distribute and unlawful possession of fentanyl (less than 4 grams or under 40 pills). She was booked into the Weld County Jail on the charges.

**Case report 26-0260:** On January 16<sup>th</sup>, at around 10:40 p.m., while on proactive patrols in the area of N. 11<sup>th</sup> Ave and E. Bridge St., our officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle with an expired temporary registration. The vehicle was occupied by three males: a 17-year-old unlicensed driver, a 13-year-old front occupant, and a 23-year-old rear occupant. During the traffic stop, our officers observed a box of ammunition sticking out of the driver's pocket, along with a large amount of drug paraphernalia and marijuana in plain view. Officers removed the occupants from the vehicle, and a gun was seen resting on the backseat of the car where the rear occupant had been sitting. The firearm was found to have been stolen out of Denver. The 13-year-old was released to the custody of

a guardian. The 17-year-old was transported to the Brighton Police Department for processing and then released to his guardian on a PR bond and pending charges. The 23-year-old was taken into custody for the stolen firearm and taken to the Brighton Police Department for processing. He was then transported to the Adams County Detention Facility.

**Case report 26-0308/0309:** On January 18<sup>th</sup>, at around 1:15 p.m., officers responded to a multiple vehicle crash in the area of I-76 and 136<sup>th</sup> Ave. The first crash was an intoxicated, reckless driver who hit the center catch fence. The second crash occurred during the traffic backup caused by the first crash. Our officers were able to maintain one lane open for both crashes. The people involved in the vehicles only reported minor injuries. The DUI driver, a 20-year-old male, was arrested on the DUI-charges and transported to the Adams County Detention Facility. The Traffic Safety Unit responded to assist with this crash.
