SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

February 2nd: News Release

Case report 26-0538: On February 3rd, at around 10:40 a.m., a reported stolen vehicle was located in the 200 block of S 2nd Ave. Officers responded to the location with a drone to verify that the vehicle was at the home. Contact was made with a 37-year-old male exiting the stolen vehicle. The male did not listen to the officers' commands and fled into the residence. The homeowner provided consent to enter, and the male was located in a crawl space under the house. The suspect had a previous motor vehicle theft (MVT) charge, which enhanced the charge to 1st degree MVT. He was also in possession of .61 g of cocaine and 1.98 g of meth. The male was transported to the Adams County Detention Facility for the MVT charges and his warrant.

Case report 26-0596: On February 6th, at around 3:35 p.m., our officer observed a suspicious vehicle driving near North 9th Avenue and East Bridge Street. The vehicle was illegally parked near the driveway of AutoZone. The driver was seen exiting the vehicle and walking away. When approaching the vehicle, officers could see drug paraphernalia in plain view, and the keys were still in the ignition. The driver, a 39-year-old male, was found a short time later in the area. He had over 17 grams of crystal meth and 0.97 grams of powdered Fentanyl in his possession. The male was placed under arrest and later booked into the Adams County Detention Facility. Detectives notified.

Case report 26-0606: On February 6th, at around 2:00 p.m., officers responded to a report of a person with a gun at Subway near South 5th Avenue and East Bromley Lane. The reporting party stated there was a male drinking alcohol by his truck in the parking lot. Officers contacted the suspect, a 26-year-old male, who was visibly intoxicated, holding an open container of alcohol. The male also had a firearm in the holster on his back. He was arrested and later booked into the Adams County Detention Facility.
