SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case report 26-0681: On February 9th, at around 11:22 p.m., officers responded to a DUI crash in the area of E 136th Ave and Buckley Road. The call stated that the driver hit a light pole, knocking it to the ground before fleeing on foot. Debris from the light pole was spread across the southbound lanes of Buckley Rd. The vehicle was found abandoned nearby and was a total loss. Officers were able to track down the driver, a 23-year-old male, at his registered address. The driver was arrested and booked into the Adams County Detention Facility.

Case report 26-0681: On February 10th, at around 7:00 p.m., officers responded to a hit-and-run between a pickup truck and a flatbed truck in the area of 13600 northbound Hwy 85. Initial investigation showed that the pickup crashed into the flatbed after it changed lanes quickly. The flatbed was carrying gravel, which was dumped all over the road during the crash. The flatbed truck fled the scene and was not located. No injuries were reported. Traffic was held up for a time while the gravel was cleaned up.

Case report 26-0706: On February 12th, at around 4:15 a.m., officers responded to the 400 block of Elm Ave on a phone message about a vehicle trespass. While on the phone, the victim, a 54-year-old male, told officers he had been shot. When officers arrived on scene, they located the victim, who had a gunshot wound to his leg. The victim stated that he was sitting in his car when a male approached him with a gun and demanded his keys. The victim was getting out of the driver's seat and handing over the keys when the suspect shot him, the bullet grazing the victim's leg. The suspect fled in a vehicle and was not located. Medical personnel arrived on scene, and the victim was treated for his injuries. This case is currently under investigation.

Case Report 26-0752: On February 14th, at around 9:30 p.m., our officers responded to an aggravated robbery in the 800 block of Goldenrod Pkwy. The victim, a 35-year-old male, said he was being held at taser and two known suspects, a 55-year-old male and a 58-year-old male, had robbed him of his trading cards, valued at \$3,000. The incident occurred at one of the suspects' homes. When officers arrived on scene, they set up a perimeter and ordered the residents out. The two male suspects exited the home and were taken into custody without incident. Both suspects were booked into the Adams County Detention Facility on the above charge.

Case report 26-0737: On February 14th, at around 11:00 p.m., officers were dispatched to an unwanted person at a hotel in the 900 block of Platte River Blvd. The suspect, a 25-year-old male, was reported to be destroying a hotel room. He was throwing items out of the 3rd story window and breaking the furniture. Officers attempted to make contact through the door, but it was locked with the deadbolt. His behavior was continuing to be more aggressive, and officers deployed OC fog under the door. They were able to make entry into the room, past the barricaded door, and place the male into custody. He was later booked into the Adams County Detention Facility on Criminal Mischief charges, as he caused more than \$4,000 of damage.
