### SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case report 26-0900: On February 24<sup>th</sup>, at around 5:00 a.m., officers responded to a rollover crash at Hwy 85 and E-470. When officers arrived on scene, the vehicle that had crashed was found unoccupied. Officers checked the area and brought in a drone, but could not locate the driver. The driver was found later in the day at a relative's house. The driver suffered minor injuries.

Case report 26-0918: On February 24<sup>th</sup>, at around 4:45 p.m., officers responded to an auto-pedestrian accident at S 9<sup>th</sup> Ave and E Egbert St. A juvenile female was crossing the road outside of a crosswalk when she was struck by a passing car. The driver of the vehicle remained on scene. The juvenile female was transported to the hospital for her injuries. The Traffic Safety Unit investigated this incident.

Case report 26-0925: On February 24<sup>th</sup>, at around 6:50 p.m., officers responded to an auto-pedestrian accident at the 1100 block of E Bridge St. A 61-year-old male had stepped out into the street and was struck by a passing motorist. The driver of the vehicle, a 38-year-old woman, stayed on scene and cooperated with officers during the investigation. The victim was transported to the hospital for his serious injuries. The Traffic Safety Unit investigated this incident.

Case report 26-0912: On February 24<sup>th</sup>, at around 2:00 p.m., Impact officers patrolling the 900 block of Brighton Drive found two male suspects with warrants. When officers attempted to make contact, one of the suspects fled, and an officer pursued him on foot. Officers were able to locate the fleeing suspect in a backyard and placed him into custody after a brief struggle. Both suspects were booked at the Adams County Detention Facility.

Case report 26-0941: On February 26<sup>th</sup>, at around 11:40 p.m., officers responded to a reported bicycle theft in the 200 block of Balsam Ave. The reporting party called in, stating someone had stolen her child's bicycle and fled with it. While officers were on the phone with the victim, they observed a suspect matching the description riding a child's bicycle. Officers approached the 33-year-old male suspect, and he confessed to the theft. The suspect was placed under arrest and transported to the Adams County Detention Facility.

Case report 26-0975: On February 27<sup>th</sup>, at around 9:30 p.m., officers responded to an explosion followed by a garage fire in the alleyway of 100 block of N 6<sup>th</sup> and N 7<sup>th</sup> Ave. Officers and Firefighters arrived to the scene quickly and discovered a detached garage fully engulfed in flames. The Firefighters immediately brought the fire under control, preventing it from spreading to nearby homes. Our officers assisted with scene safety, traffic control, and evacuating residents from their homes. The fire did spread to power poles, trees, and nearby fences. United Power Inc. responded to secure downed and arcing power lines in the area. Detectives were notified and arrived on scene with a Fire Investigator. The case is currently under investigation.
