### SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case report 26-1066: On March 5<sup>th</sup>, at around 12:45 a.m., officers on proactive patrols conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle using the wrong turn lane. When making contact with the driver, a 59-year-old male, our officers noticed that he was visibly intoxicated. After the DUI investigation was completed and the driver arrested, he admitted to "stuff" in an Altoids mint container. It contained methamphetamine, ketamine, cocaine, and acetaminophen. The driver was booked into the Adams County Detention Facility on DUI and felony drug charges.

Case report 26-1069: On March 5<sup>th</sup>, at around 10:30 a.m., officers received a report of street racing in the area of E 144<sup>th</sup> Ave and Chambers Road. Officers arrived on scene and were able to stop one of the vehicles. The teenage juvenile driver of that vehicle called the other two teenage juveniles involved, and they returned to the traffic stop. All three were issued citations for the speed contest. Two of the drivers were not licensed but had permission from their parents to drive to school. The parents were also issued citations for allowing the unlicensed drivers.

Case report 26-1102: On March 7<sup>th</sup>, at around 8:40 a.m., officers responded to a report of a motor vehicle theft. While at the Love's Travel Stop in Brighton, the victim reported seeing the two suspects who had recently stolen his truck. The suspects had stolen it a few hours prior, and the vehicle was not yet reported stolen. Officers made contact with the suspects at a nearby residence. One suspect, a 40-year-old male, ran from officers after being contacted in the stolen vehicle. The suspect was arrested and taken to Weld County Jail on Motor Vehicle Theft, along with a number of additional charges.
