SECTION 1: SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

Case report 26-1201: On March 12th, at around 6:30 p.m., officers responded to an unconscious person found on a mattress near the railroad tracks in the 500 block of North 6th Avenue. The male who was found appeared to have overdosed. Officers notified Detectives, a Victim Advocate, and the Coroner.

Case report 26-1224: On March 13th, at around 9:30 p.m., officers responded to a reported kidnapping in progress at 3738 Eagle Boulevard in Brighton. The call-in for service said that a male party had taken off with a five-year-old child in his vehicle while the mother of the child chased after them. Officers were able to conduct a traffic stop on the suspect's vehicle that was reported. After further investigation, it was determined that it was a child custody issue. The suspect, a 39-year-old male, had warrants for his arrest. He was taken into custody and booked into the Adams County Detention Facility.

Case report 26-1230: On March 14th, at around 2:30 a.m., officers responded to the Prairie Vista Youth Center on a report of a suspicious vehicle parked nearby. The call-in to dispatch said that the vehicle seemed out of place because it was parked behind a tree. Officers arrived to the scene and saw that the vehicle appeared to have crashed into a ditch. The car was unoccupied, and officers began searching the area. A person was observed walking near the train tracks, and officers made contact with an 80-year-old man who said he was at a casino. Officers were able to contact the man's wife, who confirmed he had dementia. Paramedics were called to the scene to check the male for injuries. After determining that he was okay, officers transported him back to his home in Thornton. Shortly after the initial contact, a train came down the tracks.
